#### A Message From Republic Services®

Republic Services has been contracted by the City of Minonk to provide city-wide residential recycling and waste collection. As part of the program, all residents will soon receive one (1) new 95-gallon cart to be used for every other week recycling pickup and (1) new 95-gallon cart to be used for weekly waste pickup only.

Waste pickup will occur each week on Fridays and recycling pickup will occur every other week on Fridays.

We understand there will be some growing pains with the new service roll-out, but we are confident this guide will help us provide a timely service. Please contact Republic Services at **815.723.3200** or visit **RepublicServices.com** with any questions regarding the program.



#### Placement of Carts

Recycling and waste will be serviced at the curb in front of your home. Keep the carts at least 3 feet away from all other objects such as trees, bushes, mailboxes, fencing, landscaping and your other carts.

#### PLEASE DO NOT PARK VEHICLES IN FRONT OF CARTS.



The smaller 65-gallon waste carts will be available for senior citizens at their request by contacting Republic Services directly. We ask that residents wait 60 days after the initial distribution before any changes in cart sizes can be made. Please consider that large carts are meant to not only accommodate the regular weekly amount of waste, but also the very heavy times like holidays, family gatherings and birthday parties.

#### **Additional Carts**

Additional carts may be rented for \$3.50 each per month and are billed directly to the resident.

### Roll-Off Dumpsters

Roll-off dumpsters ranging from 10 to 30 cubic yards are available for large cleanout or construction projects. Please contact Republic Services for pricing and availability.

#### Items Not Accepted

Laws require that all residents separate the following items from their landfill-bound waste for proper disposal. Please contact Republic Services for information on several convenient ways for residents to keep these materials out of landfills.

- Loose trash
- Dirt, stone and rocks
- Hazardous materials
- Liquids
- Yard waste mixed with trash
- · Large auto and truck parts

- Tires
- Televisions, computers and other electronics
- Kitchen and laundry appliances
- Paint
- Engine and machine oils

#### Bulk Item Pickup

One (1) bulk item will be picked up each week on the same day trash is collected. Bulk items are household type items, no white goods, electronics or construction material will be accepted.
